### Introduction

In August 1988, the LDRC Defense Counsel Section issued its Survey and Report on "Special Procedures and Innovative Techniques for Trying Media Libel Actions Before Juries." The Survey had inquired as to the use of "innovative" procedures and techniques by media defense attorneys in five general areas: (1) trial preparation; (2) trial-related motions (i.e., motions in limine); (3) jury selection; (4) specific trial procedures; and (5) procedures used at the jury verdict stage.

While the August, 1988 Survey and Report was helpful as an overview to the existence of certain innovative trial techniques, and provided general statistical data on the frequency of their use, that Report did not attempt to identify the specific cases in which such techniques had been employed.

To that end, in the Summer of 1989 LDRC undertook to contact the trial attorneys who had initially been surveyed for the purpose of gathering case-specific information. With such information, the initial report could be "annotated," thus creating more of a reference manual that would permit defense counsel to contact others with experience in the use of particular innovative techniques for information and advice on the use and effects of such procedures.

Ultimately, 35 of the approximately 55 attorneys who had initially been surveyed were interviewed for purposes of developing "annotations" to the Report. What follows is a listing, broken down by procedure or technique identified in the Report, of the attorneys we surveyed who employed the specific procedure or technique and the case(s) in which they were used.

As a reference, the full name, firm name, address and telephone number of each attorney listed (alphabetically by last name of attorney) is attached as Appendix A. All of those listed have indicated that they are willing to be contacted by those defense counsel wishing to obtain further information on the innovative techniques they have employed.
