In particular, it is inconsistent with academic participation in the MLRC for an academic to be engaged in active litigation against a media defendant on a content-related matter such as defamation, invasion of privacy or related claims, whether the academic member is acting as an on-the-record advocate, a behind-the-scenes consultant, or an expert witness (testifying or non-testifying). A subscription for an academic would cease if the academic undertook to represent or otherwise participate in litigation in such a matter on behalf of a plaintiff against a media defendant (including any journalist, author or other individual engaged in the acquisition or creation or publication of content for mass media) in which there was a claim for defamation, invasion of privacy or related claim.
